COVID 19 and the Northeast Chapter AAE

Starting in early 2020 the impact of the COVID 19 global pandemic had a dramatic effect on the operations on the Northeast Chapter. All in person meetings and Conferences were cancelled as directed by government regulations.

Chapter finances were seriously reduced with only dues income as a reliable source. To address the financial challenge a series of seminars focused on COVID related impacts on airport operations were offered using the ZOOM platform as a virtual meeting space. These Seminars produced revenues through registrations and sponsorships to pay the basic expenses for the year.

In that there was no annual conference which had been scheduled for Burlington, VT, the Executive Committee remained in place for one additional year with Carl Braley AAE continuing as President.

Vaccines began to become available in late 2020 and while their impact started in 2021 , the 2021 Airports Conference in Hershey, PA could not be held in person. Instead, a virtual month long event was held using the Zoom platform. Daily weekday sessions, 35 in all, with over 150 registrations and numerous sponsorships produced almost \$80,000 in revenue. The Snow Symposium was again cancelled in that it did not lend itself to a virtual event. But in August 2021 the Annual Conference was held in Burlington, VT with over 250 attendees. The Balchen/Post Awards were folded into the Burlington Conference as well as certain winter related general sessions. September also saw the return of the ARFF School in Pittsburgh, PA.

During 2021 there were additional Seminars focusing on recovery from the pandemic which produced additional revenue.

2022 brought the hope for normalcy with the March Airports Conference in Hershey, PA with over 400 in attendance producing a successful event.

In summary, and perhaps most importantly, throughout this challenging period the Chapter was able to fully fund our Scholarship programs for both the matching funds with national AAE as well as NEC initiatives.

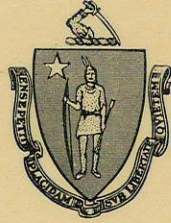

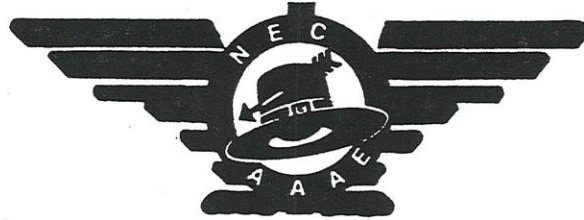
